Phonics and Reading

- In Year 2, the children will continue to use their phonic knowledge as the route to decode words until automatic decoding has been embedded and reading is fluent.
- Other aspects include:
- Developing pleasure in reading, motivation to read by listening to, discussing and expressing views on a wide range of contemporary and classic poetry, stories and non-fiction texts beyond their reading level
- Understanding by answering questions (retrieval and inference)
- · Discussing the sequence of events and how information is related
- Understanding and commenting on vocabulary
- Making plausible predictions on the basis of what they have read or heard
- Making links to other texts

Phonics and Reading

- We will change your child's book as often as needed when we can see they have finished the book
- Please ensure they have their reading diaries with them every day, even if they don't need to change them
- Please ensure you have signed their diary to say they have read their book so we know to change them.





Maths

In Year 2, the children will learn to read, write, order, compare numbers up to 100.

Other strands on the curriculum include:

- Number (place value, addition, subtraction, division and multiplication, fractions)
- Geometry (2D and 3D shapes, symmetry, position and direction)
- Measures (such as capacity, length, weight, money, time)
- Statistics (data handling)

- Animals including humans
- Everyday materials
- Plants

The other subjects in the curriculum include:

- History, Geography and Science
- Art
- Music

- PE

PE

- PE days: Wednesday and Thursday
- A full PE is required in school all week
- Label all kit
- Warm kit and a change of trainers required for outdoor games
- Kits will be sent home as and when required for washing
- Encourage children to be independent when changing
- Long hair needs to be tied back and earrings removed
- Please send a note if your child is not able to do PE

Homework

- A blue book will be given to each child for their homework. Any additional notes home will be put in the book.
- If you wish to send in a note, put it in the book or Reading Record and make it visible to the teacher.
- Homework will be given out every Friday to be returned the following Wednesday.
- Homework should take 10-15 minutes.
- Phonics exercises/maths will always relate to topic being covered in class that week.
- Spelling words 5 per week (to be checked in school the following Friday)
- Reading Books Please read every day (just 2-3 pages will do!) Please record and sign on completion and then we will change your child's book.



Settling In

 School starts at 9.00 am. When the bell rings the children need to be waiting in the pod with all their belonging ready to come into school.


- Home time is at 3.15pm. Children will be dismissed through the class door/pod area so please stand where we can see you and wave!

- Label all belongings (especially jumpers, coats, PE kits and snack pots)



- Making sure your child has an appropriate PE kit in school, for both outdoor and indoor lessons on Wednesdays and Thursday. Spare clothes can be sent in and keep on their pegs.
- Make sure your child has a coat with them. We learn outside in all weathers.
- Bringing reading diaries and books to school every day.
- Supporting your child with their reading, spelling and homework tasks.
- Recording clearly who is picking up your child at the end of the day on the clipboard.
- Show your child how to organise their belongings (putting their things in their bag).
- Teach your child to be responsible for their own belongings.
